Granville Vance Public Health is now accepting applications for the position of PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE II to work in our Public Health Clinics in Granville and Vance counties.

THE PRIMARY PURPOSE: The primary purpose of this position is to utilize the skills of a registered nurse in the highly trained and enhanced role to provide comprehensive screening assessments and provide direct care in the child health program and in the newborn/postpartum home visiting program. The Registered Nurse in this full-time position will be responsible for assessing medical, social, and psychological history in pre and post interviews with clients in our Maternal, Family Planning, and Child Health Clinics. The RN will provide nursing care in a team setting to aid in the mission of ensuring all pregnant women have access to early and continuous prenatal and postpartum care; reduce the rate of unintended pregnancies; and improve health practices among families in Granville and Vance counties. The RN will administer care and treatment, including vaccinations, through Standing Orders, Program Policies and Procedures or as prescribed by Advanced Practice Providers.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited school of professional nursing and one year of professional nursing experience. A current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in North Carolina by the N. C. Board of Nursing. All Public Health Nurses employed by a local health department shall complete an introductory course in principles and practices of public health/public health nursing and any refresher courses sponsored by the NC Department of Health and Human Services. 10A NCAC 46 .0301 (2),(b),(c).

COMPENSATION PACKAGE: GVPH offers competitive benefits including paid group medical insurance, N.C.
