MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN I

Salary Grade (62)

Salary Range: \$40,173 – \$64,221

Salary offer will be commensurate with experience, education, and equity with others in the agency upon hire.

Granville Vance Public Health is now accepting applications for the position of MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN I to work in our Public Health Clinics in Granville and Vance counties.

THE PRIMARY PURPOSE: This full-time Medical Laboratory Technician I position is responsible for the performance of a limited number of routine, standardized tests, and the daily operational functions of a small (usually one person) medical laboratory. Tests are performed to aid in the diagnosis of disease and treatment of patients. Positions with daily laboratory operational management responsibilities are primarily located in local public health agencies offering a limited variety of medical laboratory tests and services. Employees work with considerable independence in the application of knowledge and techniques to the work area and are held accountable for quality control and test results. This position will assure appropriate specimen collection and processing according to the NC State Laboratory of Public Health, reference laboratories and agency protocols. The ideal candidate will perform routine and standardized tests where the test results are specific, predictable and require minimal interpretation. Lab is rated “Moderately Complex” by CLIA 88.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Completion of a certified laboratory assistant course in medical technology or a comparable course; or high school or General Educational Development diploma and two years of medical laboratory experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Minimum Education and Experience for a Trainee Appointment: High school or General Educational Development diploma and one year of general laboratory experience.

COMPENSATION PACKAGE: GVPH offers competitive benefits including paid group medical insurance, NC Local Government Employees Retirement System membership, thirteen paid holidays, two additional floating holidays, and vacation and sick leave. Other voluntary group benefit options are available, including 401(k), 457(b), dental insurance, life insurance, vision insurance and flexible spending accounts.
