The Granville-Vance Public Health (GVPH) is currently recruiting for a full-time Social Worker II Care Manager to work in our Care Management for At Risk Pregnancies Program. Preferred experience in Case Management or Obstetrics.

THE PRIMARY PURPOSE: The Social Worker in this position will be responsible for working as a team member as an Obstetrics Care Manager (OBCM). The North Carolina Division of Public Health, in partnership with the North Carolina Division of Health Benefits and Community Care of North Carolina (CCNC), has implemented a Pregnancy Medical Home Initiative, which is inclusive of Pregnancy Care Management (OBCM) services. The goal of the Pregnancy Medical Home (PMH) model is to improve the quality of maternity care, improve birth outcomes, and provide continuity of care. The model involves engaging obstetrical providers as Pregnancy Medical Homes and local health departments as providers of Pregnancy Care Management services.

Pregnancy Care Management services are provided for pregnant Medicaid recipients who are determined to be at risk for poor birth outcomes. All PMH providers are required to complete a pregnancy risk screening, at the initial prenatal visit, to identify these and other risk factors. Non-PMH prenatal care providers can also refer their patients for Pregnancy Care Management services. Additionally, referrals can be made by partner entities that provide services to pregnant Medicaid recipients.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Social workers with bachelor's degree in social work (BSW, BA in social work, or BS in social work) or master's degree in social work (MSW, MA in social work, or MS in social work) from a Council on Social Work Education accredited social work degree program.

COMPENSATION PACKAGE: GVPH offers competitive benefits including paid group medical insurance, N.C. Local Government Employees Retirement System membership, twelve paid holidays, and vacation and sick leave. Other voluntary group benefit options are available, including 401(k), 457(b), dental insurance, life insurance, vision insurance and flexible spending accounts.
